

TBO Holocaust Memorial: Honoring the Victims -- Bearing Witness to their Names

7:00 a.m. – 7:15 p.m.

Six million Jews, one and a half million of them children, were slaughtered by the Nazis during the Holocaust. In solidarity with congregations worldwide, please join us, your friends and neighbors to remember those who were persecuted and killed because of their Jewish faith. Reduced to numbers, not names, we must never forget.

Temple Beth Or's program of remembrance is part of the worldwide commemoration: Unto Every Person There Is A Name. We begin in the Temple Beth Or sanctuary at 7 a.m. and will continue for twelve consecutive hours as we read the victims' names aloud. By remembering them individually, we will bear witness to their suffering and deaths. We invite you to read their names aloud (in person) in ten-minute time slots spread out over the twelve hours and to bear witness to others reading names for as long as it moves you during the day, in person in the pews or by watching our livestream.

A brief memorial service at the conclusion of the day will be highlighted by guest speaker Steve Goldberg, who will share the amazing story of Abe Piasek, Holocaust survivor and TBO member who sadly passed away 3 years ago at the beginning of the Pandemic. Steve will recall Abe's amazing journey during the war, his time spent in various camps and his eventual landing spot here in North Carolina. This presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m. and will be followed by a 7:00 p.m. memorial service.
